CURRENT LANGUAGE:

- B10.01.01 The annual meeting of the congregation will be held the last Sunday in January. The time of the meeting will be included in the notification as indicated in C10.03 of this constitution.
- C10.03. Notice of all meetings of this congregation shall be given at the services of worship on the preceding two consecutive Sundays and by mail or electronic means, as permitted by state law, to all voting members at least 10 days in advance of the date of the meeting.

PROPOSED LANGUAGE:

- B10.01.01 The annual meeting of the congregation *will ideally be held the last Sunday in January. However, in extreme circumstances, the Redeemer Council has the right to adjust the date.* The time of the meeting will be included in the notification as indicated in C10.03 of this constitution.
