There was a shortfall in November. \$500 was transferred to cover the shortfall. \$105 from Memorial Fund and \$395 from the Bennett savings account.

There is a \$10,000. CD coming due from part of the Hinzman money from the general savings account on January 16, 2024.

Motion was made by Rick Olson to put this money into a 7 month CD at 5.25% with Farmer's and Merchant's Union Bank. Seconded by Dean Roberts. Motion carried. All were in favor. Authorized signers would remain the same for now.
